The COVID-19 pandemic has brought many changes to the routines we follow in providing services to the 750+ residents who live independently or are cared for in the healthcare residences on our Baptist Homes and Providence Point campuses. In accordance with the recommendations, guidelines, and directives of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), and the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PA DOH), we:

- Have restricted visitation on both campuses,
- Screen all staff and visitors for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 or elevated temperatures each time they enter our buildings,
- Require all staff to wear face masks as a source control measure,
- Provide staff working with COVID-19 positive or presumptive positive cases with full Personal Protective Equipment (PPE),
- Have reinforced with all staff the need to adhere to standard infection control measures, including frequent handwashing and hand sanitizing, proper sneeze and cough etiquette, and appropriate social distancing, and
- Have temporarily eliminated all communal dining, group activities and events.

By the grace of God, these measures, along with the diligence of our staff, have been successful in containing the spread of the COVID-19 virus within our communities. There have been no new cases of COVID-19 on either campus in the past two weeks.

Throughout the COVID-19 crisis, we have only had three residents who tested positive for COVID-19. As of today, one of the two residents who had remained in our COVID care unit has recovered from the coronavirus infection, as evidenced by two subsequent negative COVID-19 test results, and has been moved out of isolation. The second resident is currently asymptomatic and has been tested and we are awaiting results to confirm a negative COVID-19 status. There are currently no residents who are symptomatic for COVID-19 on either campus.

Throughout the COVID-19 crisis, we have had a total of 14 staff and contracted staff members who have tested positive for COVID-19. Of these 14 individuals, one is able to return to work due to the time lapse from the 1st positive test (asymptomatic for >32 days), two have returned to work subsequent to two negative test results, four have tested negative and we are awaiting a second negative test result prior to returning them to work, and seven are currently undergoing testing to determine a negative COVID-19 status. There are currently no staff members who exhibit symptoms of COVID-19.

We have not had any residents test positive for COVID-19 in the past 22 days (since April 16), and we have had no additional staff members test positive in the past 14 days (since April 24).

Please continue to keep Baptist Homes Society, our residents and our staff in your prayers.
