Subject: Weekly COVID-19 Update

Baptist Homes Society continues our ongoing battle with the COVID-19 virus. Since our last weekly update on January 15, 2021, one personal care resident, one skilled nursing and one laundry staff member on the Baptist Homes campus tested positive for COVID-19. At Providence Point, one memory support resident, two skilled nursing and one contracted staff member, along with two independent living residents have all tested positive for COVID-19.

The skilled nursing, personal care, and memory support residences continue to follow federal and state mandates. Staff and visitors continue to be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 at the time of entering our buildings. Staff and visitors must wear a mask at all times while on our campuses, inside or outside our buildings. All skilled nursing and personal care residents should wear masks at all times except when eating or showering. All packages for healthcare residents are to be left outside our entrances for delivery by our staff.

We are pleased that COVID-19 vaccinations for skilled nursing residents and staff were administered on both campuses. Vaccinations for personal care residents and staff began yesterday on the Baptist Homes campus and will be done today on the Providence Point campus.

We take the health, safety, and security of our residents very seriously. As you know, COVID-19 can have very serious health complications, possibly leading to hospitalization or even death. **We strongly encourage you to NOT take your family member out of Baptist Homes or Providence Point for an outing or visit. Getting together in groups increases the risk to your loved one.**

In order to help to contain the spread of COVID-19 and to keep ourselves, our families, and the residents we serve free from the COVID-19 virus, each of us must be diligent to continue to:

- Wear masks both while at work, as well as outside your home in the community.
- Wear masks appropriately, **ensuring mask covers both nose AND mouth,**
- Practice social distancing of 6 feet or more and avoid gatherings of more than 10 people,
- Continue to observe appropriate cough and sneeze etiquette,
- Continue to wash hands frequently for at least 20 seconds with soap and water, and
- Use hand sanitizer frequently when hand washing is not practicable.

Thank you for your continued understanding, cooperation, and compliance with all of the measures that are in place due to COVID-19.
